SCYA MIDWINTER REGATTA

Don't forget that Southern California Yachting Association's Midwinter Regatta is coming to Newport Beach on February 16th and 17th. The SCYA Midwinter Regatta is one of the largest in the United States, involving over 2500 sailors and motor yacht captains in California, Arizona and Nevada. Over 600 boats compete in a variety of venues sponsored by approximately 25 SCYA member clubs in two weekends of competition.

American Legion Yacht Club will be the Organizing Authority and they'll be starting the boats off the Newport Pier. South Shore Yacht Club will be the venue for hosting the Trophy Party on Sunday, February 17th at 6:30 PM in the downstairs Islander Room. Remember, it's the mid-West and East Coast Yacht Clubs that go dormant in the winter months, but not us! There will be lots of fun sailing opportunities coming up in 2019.

ENSENADA TUNE-UP AND NEWPORT-TO-ENSENADA

The Ensenada Tune-Up Race has been organized by South Shore Yacht Club and Dana Point Yacht Club for the past 24 years! This year will mark the 25th Silver Anniversary for this joint venture between our two yacht clubs. We typically have around 25 boats that use this race as an opportunity to fine tune their vessels for the 125 mile Newport-to-Ensenada race that is scheduled for the last full weekend in April, specifically April 26-27. If you can't be in the race on a boat, SSYC will be responsible for four running 5-minute race starting sequences. It's a lot of fun!
